Nothing short of a blistering trade with all types of lambs extremely well competed for. Strongest short keep lambs sold to an exceptional £87.50 medium keep lambs topped at £76 and more could have very easily been sold. A large number of longer term smaller and harder bred lambs were forward and these found a trade full of confidence for the later end of the fat hogget season.
