PRE- MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) within 60 days of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!

FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

STORE SHEEP: 915

Another week to record a blistering sale at Worcester. Lambs would look dearer than previous sales. No real strength forward but larger framed lambs sold to £71. The market average of £57.17 includes very small weak sheep.

GRAZING EWES: 31

Plenty of men, plenty of bidding, not enough grazing Ewes! Stronger ewes sold to £73 and averaged £65 If you have lean ewes – bring them on a Saturday!

Please book your sheep in to the sales, it really helps maximize your returns.
