A ewe trade which was slightly stronger but still very selective. Some of the dearest sheep were in fact two year olds which reached £126.00 and averaged £115.00 right the way through. North Country Mule yearlings reached £120.00. As regards the sale of ewe lambs there was a firm level of demand right the way through with the prize winners in the show class being:

Highest price of the day was £101.00 for some Texel X ewe lambs. Texel X ewe lambs sold in the main between £70.00 and £101.00. Suffolk X ewe lambs reached high £90's and more farming sorts between £59.00 and £66.00. The overall average for all ewe lambs was £72.50.

STORE LAMBS

Store lambs, a small entry of store lambs for the extra sale in the month found a very strong trade indeed selling to £65.00 and averaging £53.51.

STORE SHEEP - 222

An entry with some nice store lambs in it for the annual show and sale. The Peter Seabury Trophy was awarded to Mr T Caines, Hillside Farm for a pen of Texel X mixed lambs which made £64.00. Mr Caine also had the second prize pen of lambs being Suffolk X's. Third prize was won by EJH Williams and Son, Ashfield.

The trade was competitive by comparison with all other recent sales.

Medium store lambs sold up to £66.60 and averaged £62.20. Smaller store lambs sold to £60.00 and averaged £57.00. Hill lambs sold up to £47.00 and averaged £41.00.

Nearly all of the ewes on offer were sold with Zwartbles full mouthed ewes at £71.50 and £70.00 and mixed age Texel X ewes at £77.00. Beulah stock ewes sold to £40.00.
