STORE CATTLE

A good crowd of buyers in Ludlow, all looking for cattle to feed over the winter months. A two tier market looks to be developing with feed prices continuing to rise. Better breed strong types were easily sold.

FEEDING COWS (OTMS)

If you have cull cows that are coming in a bit on the lean side, then please consider this section.

FEEDING BULLS

A part of the sale that goes from strength to strength. Even with strong grain prices buyers are committing to feeding bulls. Please remember that farm assurance is very important with the 90 day residence period.

Bulls topped at £1,200 or 2.38ppk and averaged £840 or 1.98ppk (to include dairy types)

FEEDING HEIFERS

A mixed yard with some good strong feeding sorts all selling well and some other types showing the effects of the summer weather. Having said this, Ludlow has buyers for all types.

Heifers reached £1,120 or 2.20ppk to average £730 or 1.85ppk (to include dairy and native sorts)

FEEDING STEERS

100% clearance with buyers gaining a premium for the quality on offer.

Steers made £1,170 or 2.23ppk to average £830 or 1.86ppk

STORE SHEEP - 4544

STORE LAMBS – 3286

A larger entry of store lambs forward met a good trade for the quality and size on offer. We had a large entry of smaller thinner, which would be long term feeding lambs. A good number of buyers attended and were keen for all types at a price. The steady fit lamb trade is keeping a lid on the store lamb trade at present and buyers are proceeding with caution at present. Store lambs sold to £74 per head from W& C Amphlett and averaged a credible £57 per head.

Strong store lambs sold between £60 - £74 per head
Medium store lambs sold between £50 - £60 per head
Small store lambs sold between £40 - £50 per head
Mini store lambs sold between £25 - £35 per head

BREEDING EWES – 1248

A sale where the price matched the ewes. 81% were sold and in general, prices met vendors expectations. True, the yearling ewes were less money, but against previous sales the trade would be comparable for what was on offer. Yearling ewes sold up to £131. Three year old ewes sold to £96. Mixed two and three year old Texel x Welsh ewes sold to £79. There was a sense of realism about the trade and where it's been this year and considering the prices reported elsewhere, this actually was a result.

CALVES & WEANLINGS – 6

A small entry of Continental x calves sold to an excellent trade with a number of buyers forward. The calves sold to £1155 per head for a Limousin x bull calf from C M Wellings and averaged £328 per head though all the calves forward. Bull calves averaged £328 per head up to £455 per head
Heifer calves averaged £330 per head

More calves are required for every store sale to meet buyers demands.
